

**Invitation letter to the Presidents of the Forums for candidates for the scientific commission of  
the 2nd European Convention in Rome on 9, 10 and 11 July 2021 on the theme:  
«What passes between generations».**

Dear Colleague,

in accordance with the message of September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019 from the Scientific Commission of the First European Convention held in Paris in July 2019 and the Protocol to the European Conventions,

as representatives in office at the end of the previous conference (in France, Italy, Spain and from the second Convention also the representative of the multilingual area), we are responsible for the composition of the commissions for the **second European Convention** to be held in **Rome on 9, 10 and 11 July 2021** on the theme: **«What passes between generations».**

As you know, we decided to continue the experience and, after debate and voting, to keep the same form: one School Day, two IF days.

Regarding the composition of the scientific commission: "it comprises two colleagues from each zone. The Representative plus one other colleague. The latter is chosen by the Representative, in consultation with the Presidents of the zones or Forums [one for France, two for Spain (F9 and FOE), three for Italy (FPL, *Praxis*-FCL, FLdI), six for the multilingual zone]. Where the zone comprises several Forums or groupings of Forums, permutation will have to be ensured."

As for the scientific committees of the *Rendez-vous*, the person chosen by the Representative, in consultation with the Presidents of the Zones or Forums, should be elected at international level, either as a current or past member of the CRIF, or as a current or past member of the CIG.

On the basis of these principles, we invite you to be part of the scientific commission of the second European Convention.

With a view to the agenda and the Protocol, please reply by 30 September.
